PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

On May 13th we were fortunate to visit the Greene County Career Center's (GCCC) new main campus (completed in 2020) and receive a tour from its Superintendent, Dave Deskins. Mr. Deskins has over 20 years in educational leadership in public, private, and career technology centers and was instrumental in the design, funding, and construction of this facility, which is quite

impressive. He explained that the GCCC serves almost 800 students and has numerous high school-level technical and vocational

programs. These programs are structured to produce skilled candidates for the employers in our area, many of whom participate as advisors in helping GCCC choose and design its programs. In a typical year approximately 60% if its graduates advance to some type of post-

secondary training. During the last school year, its students earned over 500 industry credentials, including professional certifications, which demonstrates GCCC's value to the businesses and government agencies in our region. We are grateful that Mr. Deskins agreed to meet with us on a Saturday; we all learned a lot about the GCCC and its operations.





Our next event is a Dayton Clodbusters game at Carillon Historical Park on June 4th at 1:00 PM. The Clodbusters will play the Deep River Grinders from Hobart, Indiana. As you may be aware, the Coldbusters are Dayton's oldest vintage base ball club and play the game as it was played in the 1860's, when "base ball" was still two words. Players do not use gloves, pitchers throw underhanded to facilitate batters (called "strikers" back then) hitting the ball, and a batter is out if a ball is caught after one bounce. In other words, come and watch the players party as if it was 1869. There is no admission fee. Remember to take your lawn chair, and any refreshments you bring must be nonalcoholic. After the game, however, you can meet with your MOAA friends on the outside patio of the Carillon Brewing Company, the nation's only production

brewery in a museum. German, Irish, and English brews are available. In addition to the base ball game, Carillon Historical Park offers other things to see and do. The park is a 65-acre open-air history museum with a focus on Dayton's past. Baseball is also our event in July. See details later in the newsletter
